



PRONOUN POLICY

Coyote Central believes that each person has the right to be referred to in a way that affirms their gender identity. We commit to creating a safe and supportive space for all members of our community by: opening gatherings with names and pronouns; including pronouns in our email signatures; having staff members on hand to answer questions or concerns; and offering tools that provide clarity and build confidence with correct pronoun usage.

If someone is misgendering you or you notice someone being misgendered at Coyote Central, talk to your teaching artist or to a Coyote staff member and they will help you address the situation.
